Marciana National Library


The Marciana Library, honorary member of our Association, has a strong cultural bond with Via Querinissima.

In fact, it is precisely at the Marciana that the diary of Cristofalo Fioravante and Nicolò de Michiel and that of Pietro Querini are preserved. But that's not all, among the rich cultural heritage of the Library we also find Fra' Mauro's globe, which bears witness to Pietro Querini's passage to Norway.

The Biblioteca Nazionale Marciana, one of the oldest libraries in Italy, was already conceived as 'public' by Francesco Petrarca, who first conceived the project of an open library in the heart of the Venetian Republic. The Library confirms its mission as a place dedicated to reading and study in the city and to the promotion, dissemination and knowledge of its extremely rich bibliographic heritage preserved and made accessible in the main building, i.e. that of the former Mint.

Røst is a municipality in Nordland County, Norway, beyond the Arctic Circle of the southwestern tip of the Lofoten Islands archipelago.

The climate is cool in summer and the North Atlantic Current means that the temperature is relatively mild in winter.

The island's economic activity is related to **fishing**, **especially cod**, and the production of stockfish.

In 1932, on the occasion of the 500th anniversary of the shiwrecked of Querini and his crew the inhabitants of Røst erected a **monument** on the island of Sandøya.

Festa del Bacalà in Sandrigo

In September, the most delicious festival ever took place in Sandrigo: the Festa del Bacalà.

There were several initiatives linked to the Via Querinissima, let us recall them together:

- 21 September "In the footsteps of Querini: Malvasia & Bacalhau" a talk and masterclass with the Confraternity of Bacalà and the Unione Cuochi del Veneto. Also on the same day, the cultural prize 'La Querina' was awarded, with the illustrator, comic book writer, storyboard artist and live action artist

Paolo Cossi, who authored a comic book about the story of Pietro Querini "1432. Il veneziano che scoprì il baccalà and the journalist, historian and eco-historian and consultant Einar Stamnes with his publication "Røst. Ytterst i Lofoten"

- From 21 to 25 September: an exhibition of ceramic works "*Under Water World - rivelazione di un mondo nascosto*" on the theme of Bacalà by the Fabris High School of Nove supported by Via Querinissima.
