Two journalists follow in Pietro Querini's footsteps to Santiago

Two journalists from the magazine *Hola Viajes* retraced Pietro Querini's route.

In September Journalist Elena Ortega and photographer Gonzalo Azumendi completed the Maritime Route of the Ría de Muros Noia, a Jacobean route that largely follows the traces of Pietro Querini's journey to Norway.

On Tuesday 10th, they set sail from the Yacht Club Monterreal in Baiona on board a sailboat belonging to the Sailway company, a regular partner of the Camino de la Ría de Muros Noia. During their maritime pilgrimage, they visited several marinas in the Rías Baixas, where they stamped their pilgrim credentials.

On Thursday 12th, they landed at the port of Muros and, after exploring some of the most evocative places of the Ría da Estrela, they continued on foot to complete the overland section of the Camino, following in the footsteps of Pietro Querini, until they reached the tomb of the Apostle Santiago and obtained the precious Compostela.

An extraordinary adventure, which we look forward to seeing recounted and illustrated in the pages of their magazine.
