Camiño de Santiago de la Ría de Muros Noia

The Muros & Noia Way is a well-kept secret along the Way of St James. It has only recently been officially recognised and attracts pilgrims looking for a mix of **coastal attractions, culinary delights, breathtaking views and a deep connection with nature**. It is an ideal retreat away from the busy paths of the Way of St James.

This route is characterised by a unique feature: the pilgrimage can start from two different points that form a fork-shaped pattern on the map. Pilgrims who choose this route can start from either the northern or southern edge of the estuary, which emphasises the bifurcation of the route.
