Cultural Routes of the Council Of Europe

Via Querinissima submitted its dossier for certification as a Council of Europe Cultural Route in July.

Why is this certification so prestigious? Let's find out together

The European Commission defines it as: "an invitation to travel and discover Europe's rich and varied heritage, bringing people and places together in networks of shared history and heritage. They put the values of the Council of Europe into practise: Human Rights, Cultural Diversity, Intercultural Dialogue and mutual exchange across borders".

The programme was launched by the Council of Europe in 1987 with the Declaration of Santiago de Compostela.

To obtain certification, destinations must carry out innovative activities and projects in five priority areas of action: cooperation in research and development; valorisation of memory, history and European heritage; cultural and educational exchanges for young Europeans; contemporary artistic and cultural practises; cultural tourism and sustainable cultural development.

Cultural routes provide a model for sustainable transnational tourism development and promote synergies at national, regional and local levels.

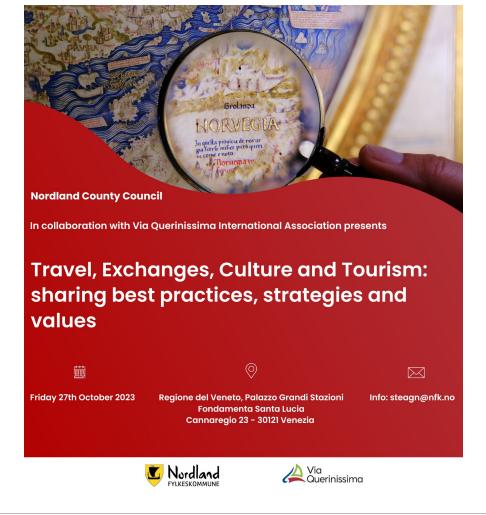
