Story of Querina/La Storia della Querina Exhibition

There are different ways to tell a story.

Franco Fortunato has succeeded in recounting Pietro Querini's adventures in the North Sea through his paintings.

These are the words of the painter Fortunato: As on other occasions, I try to translate the emotions contained in the story into images, breaking down the material and recomposing it into a new unity, to take a new journey of the imagination. I did not want to look at images of places, which exist and have their own forms, their own orography, planimetry, botany, extension and climate, all surrounded by water and frost and wind, but I drew what I imagined following the thread of the story. If of the landscape one can have a real vision, of everything else this is not possible unless one imagines it or has some knowledge of seafaring or from painting. Ships and boats only have evocative forms, deliberately without technical documentation. Only elaborations of the personal imagination.

In addition, a **short film** was also made from his works: "Using mixed media boards specially produced for the video format, and through a play of real camera movements that create depths and blurs, cuts and overlaps, the images conceived by the master are reworked and fused together to create a single film work".

The short film was acquired by Rai Storia, an Italian television channel, and broadcast during a programme by historian Alessandro Barbero.


Four very popular and lively evenings dedicated to the Via Querinissima!




VINTERLYSFESTIVALEN

BODØ 2024 EUROPEAN CAPITAL OF CULTURE AND THE NETWORK OF CULTURAL ROUTES IN EUROPE

April 25th at 5.30 pm, Via Querinissima will be protagonist at an important and international event in Oslo.

The European Union National Institutes for Culture – EUNIC Cluster Norway is presenting an international round table with panelists and experts debating on the role and potential of the European Capitals of Culture and the network of the Cultural Routes in Europe.

The discussion will investigate the relation between cultural heritage promotion and sustainability, sustainable tourism, technology and cultural promotion, with the aim, among others, to gain and spread knowledge about the possibilities of using media and digital techniques in the area of tourism. During the event, Via Querinissima and other Cultural Routes will be presented, along with two of this year's European Capitals of Culture, the Bodø 2024 and the Bad Ischl Salzkammergut 2024 projects..
